

I can't Believe that Spring is Almost Here!

One of the things I love about March is that this is the month that we officially transition from winter to spring. Even though Northwest Ohio can experience snow as late as April, we see a significant leaning towards beautiful weather in March and April each year. During the season of Lent, we often look at our spiritual life through the lenses of Christ's death and resurrection. Jesus' closest friends were intimately aware of the battle between the spirit and the flesh. While on the mountain praying, Jesus said to them, "Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak." (Matthew 26:41, NIV) Lent is a season of transition. Some of the tools we use to strengthen our spirit and, in turn, weaken our flesh, are prayer, contemplation, fasting, and community worship. Our prayer for each person at Church of the Cross, is that we would transition more into a life of faith that strengthens our spirit as we look intently at Jesus' finished work on the Cross.

This month, on Sunday mornings, we will continue our work in a series from the book of Luke, titled, "Jesus in the Wild." NURSERY NEWS

WIGGLES AND GIGGLES ROOM: Infants up to 2 years old

Staffed? No, this is a room for parents to bring their little ones who may need a break from the service (to be fed, to play, etc)

Will I miss the service? No- The service is live-streamed

TODDLER/PRESCHOOL MINISTRY: 2 yr olds through Pre-K

Staffed? Yes-there will be a paid caregiver and volunteers Curriculum: "Simply Loved"



What is Kid's Worship? It's a way for our kids to receive an age-appropriate and interactive Bible lesson, learn Bible basics, learn Scripture, sing songs, make friends, win prizes and more!

Who is it for? K-5th graders

When is It? After the Children's Message (during 10:30am church service)

How Does it Work? Parents-Check-in their kids before going into the Sanctuary for Worship. The check-in is located outside the Sanctuary doors, to the left. Kids will start in the Sanctuary with their families, at the beginning of the Worship Service, and will participate in Worship until after the Children's Message. They will be released down to the KidZone after the Children's Message. Kids will need to be picked up promptly after the service down in the KidZone.

Creation meeting - Did Jesus Really Rise From the Dead?

Creation Meeting: Monday evening March 27 at 7 PM in the Gathering Area. The apostle Paul describes the resurrection of Christ as central to the Christian faith in 1 Corinthians 15. Without the bodily resurrection of our Lord, "our faith is futile and we are still in our sins" (1 Cor. 15:17) and "we are of all people most to be pitied" (1 Cor. 15:19). But many skeptics of Christianity say Jesus did not rise from the dead.

How can Christians counter these claims? Is there evidence that Jesus did indeed rise on the third day? Equip yourself to defend the truth and historicity of the bodily resurrection of our Lord in this powerful presentation. Tim Chaffee is the content manager for the Attractions Division of Answers In Genesis. An apologist with a passion for training young peo-

ple, he speaks regularly at the Creation Museum. Camps, schools, and churches, and has authored numerous books.




Congregational notes
